


### Introduction

### What is Canva and why is it useful?

Canva is an online graphic design platform that makes the job of creating stylish social media graphics easier. Where software such as Photoshop or Illustrator are robust in their functionality, they can also have a very steep learning curve. 
Allows you to pick pre-designed templates for your graphics.

If you're using your own images, logo, and other resources, this can be - helpful to keep track of everything and have it available for other projects.







Has graphic elements you can use to spruce up your image.

Where you can create folders with items you've liked and/or purchased on Canva. Canva is free, but it has a premium option, with more items available in each category.  $\widehat{N}$ 











Image Toolbar




Image Toolbar


Contrast

### Try to use large images

It is better to scale down an image than to scale it up. Scaling an image up can make it become "pixelated" and won't look as nice.

#### Pay attention to the contrast between the background and the text!

If the brightness of your text and background are similar, it'll be hard to read.

### "Brevity is the soul of wit."

Don't have too many words on one image. Choose fragments carefully, condense what you need to say. If either is not possible, consider making several images instead of just one.

### Look at how others create social media graphics.

You can learn a lot by looking at the way others do it successfully—or unsuccessfully.
